

INSTALLING LIGHTS ON GUTTERS

Here are some suggested steps when installing lights on Gutters:

SUGGESTED STEPS FOR INSTALLING C9/C7 LIGHTS ON GUTTERS USING THE GUTTER SNAP:

- 1. First, install the Carriage Snap around the housing of the C9 or C7 bulbs (See first tip below)
- 2. Snap the Gutter Snap on the bottom of the Carriage Snap
- 3. Slide Gutter Snap on the gutter

HELPFUL TIPS WHEN USING THE CARRIAGE SNAP:

- You can make the C9/C7 lights point up, down, or straight out using the Carriage Snap. To have the lights point out, place the housing of the light inside the carriage. Slide one side of the wire in one bottom slot and the other side of the wire in the other bottom slot. It helps if you twist and slide in the slot at the same time. It will be a snug fit so it will not fall off. To point lights up or down, slide the wire through the top slots of the Carriage Snap and push in all the way.
- When removing from the gutter, keep the Carriage Snap on the light and the Gutter Snap attached to the Carriage Snap (remove the entire unit from the gutter). For installation next year, just slide the Gutter Snap back with the light already attached.

HELPFUL TIPS IF INSTALLING LIGHTS ON LEAF GUARDS USING THE CARRIAGE AND GUTTER SNAPS:

- There are various types of leaf guards. If the leaf guard has a small gap between the guard and the gutter, the Gutter Snap can often fit in that gap. Just slide the Gutter Snap in that gap.
- If there is no gap between the hood of the leaf guard and the gutter and the hood of the guard is solid and smooth, you can stick a Sticky Snap on the hood and attach the Carriage Snap. Follow steps below for the Sticky Snap:
 - Install the Carriage Snap around the housing of the C9 or C7 bulbs (See first tip below)
 - 2. Ensure that the surface of the leaf guard is clean
 - 3. Snap the Sticky Snap on the bottom of the Carriage Snap
 - 4. Peel the red 3M cover off the back of the Sticky Snap.
 - Do not touch the sticky back or it will lose its stick due to the oils on your finger

- When removing lights, keep the snap on the leaf guard. You may want to secure the snap with your finger when unsnapping the lights.
- If the leaf guard does not have a smooth surface or a gap then you can use the Screw Snap (included). Replace existing screws with the Screw Snap (that align with the spacing of the lights) or add a screw Snap where needed.

*To install String Lights (i.e. icicle lights) on gutters see the directions for the Zip Snap.
